1. Best Practices in Institute Campus by Horticulture Department

- **Composting Pit**

A Composting pit is made in Institute campus to recycle garden waste and other organic materials into nutrient rich compost. This method is low-cost, space-efficient and requires minimum maintenance which ensures the compost provides soil enrichment by improving soil structure, fertility and water retention and provides an effective way to recycle garden waste and other organic materials into nutrient-rich compost thus helping in waste reduction. The finished compost is used in garden soil, mulch and as a potting mix for potted plants. This composting pit is simple, eco- friendly way to recycle organic waste and create nutrient-rich compost for Institute campus lawns along with environmental benefits such as improving soil health, reducing landfill waste, reducing use of chemical fertilizers and conserves water as compost improves soil's water retention, reducing the need of frequent watering.

- **Nursery**

The institute campus plant nursery is a dedicated facility for propagating, nurturing and maintaining a variety of plants for educational, environment and aesthetic purposes. It serves as a hub for students, faculty and staff to engage in horticulture activities, research and sustainability as well as community engagement by encouraging participants from student and staff in gardening activities and tree planting drives in the institute campus. The plants are also used as souvenirs for guests. Campus nursery has varieties of ornamental plants, native plants, fruit plants, medical plants and indoor plants. Campus Nursery provides Social, Economic as well as Environmental benefits and is a valuable asset that contributes to sustainability and community engagement.
